Tour Itinerary

Monday 27th June 2022

Departing Stone this morning, we journey to Yorkshire with a stop en-route to (coffee at own expense) Denby Pottery. We travel to Brodsworth Hall and Gardens in time for light refreshments (at own expense) or bring a packed lunch. Brodsworth was built in the 1860's and home to the same family for over 120 years, the interiors were conserved making this house frozen in time. The glorious gardens spectacularly restored to their full Victorian splendour, with time to roam the grounds, discover the unique Rose garden, the fern dell grotto, statue walks or take in the views of the formal gardens from the summerhouse. We continue our journey to The Bridge Hotel & Spa, our home for the next 4 nights. Time to relax and settle in before dinner. (D)

Tuesday 28th June 2022

After breakfast, we make our way to Daleside Nurseries. Established in 1958, Daleside Nurseries is family owned, growing and selling an extensive range of quality plants with most of them grown on their 8 hectare nursery. We continue to RHS Garden Harlow Carr where you will have plenty of time to enjoy exploring some of its 27.5 hectares (68 acres), as well as enjoy lunch (at own expense). The garden's set in a valley and very much a part of the Yorkshire countryside, has a wide variety of growing landscapes, from running and still water to woodland and wildflower meadows. We leave RHS Harlow Carr in the late afternoon with time to relax before enjoying your evening at the hotel. (B,D)

Wednesday 29th June 2022

This morning, we split into two groups, with one heading to Golden Acre Park and the other to York Gate, before alternating in the afternoon. Light refreshments are available on both sites (at own expense). Golden Acre Park is a beautiful park set in 179 acres of mature woodland with gardens surrounding an attractive lake. Home to many varieties of trees, shrubs and herbaceous plants as well as a host of native animals and wildfowl. York Gate one of Perennial's gardens, a magical one-acre garden created by the Spencer family between 1951 and 1994. The design of 'rooms' interlinked through a succession of vistas and executed with meticulous attention to detail owe much to the Arts & Crafts movement. Perhaps sit on the wonderful sun terrace overlooking the newly created sunken Mediterranean garden. Arrive back at the hotel in time for dinner. (B,D)

Tour Itinerary

Thursday 30th June 2022

Departing the hotel after breakfast, we journey to Burnby Hall. Pocklington's unique Gardens have justifiably been called "a jewel in Yorkshire's crown" and are home to a National Collection of over eighty varieties of Hardy Water Lilies which bloom on the Upper and Lower Lakes between June and August. Wander round the different areas; The Aviary Garden, the Rock Garden, the Secret Garden, a small but unique garden designed by students from nearby Bishops Burton College and the Victoria Garden, originally an orchard and then a rose garden. Early lunch (at own expense) at Breezy Knees Gardens and Nursery, before exploring the 20 acres bursting with colour and described by Monty Don as "a beautiful modern garden created on the grandest possible scale", Breezy Knees features award winning gardens and a specialist perennial nursery. Arrive back at the hotel with time to relax before dinner. (B,D)

Friday 1st July 2022

After breakfast, we make our way to Stillingfleet Lodge Garden and Plant Nursery coffee and refreshments available (at own expense). An organically managed, wildlife friendly, family garden close to York. Described as a quintessentially English garden, it is first and foremost a family garden, lovingly planted up over 40 years by owners Vanessa and John Cook. Later we visit Don Witton's Firvale Allotments, displaying 500+ herbaceous perennials including the National Collection of Euphorbias with 124 varieties flowering between March and October. We then journey back to Stone with a comfort stop en-route. (B)
